Some issues of concern to our Association are as follows:

York Federation of Ratepayer's Associations

The York Federation is a federation of the majority of the Resident and Ratepayer groups from the Borough of York, and deals with matters which generally concern all groups. Jim Pole-Langdon was installed as President of the Federation last month, after the resignation of Mr. Bert Stollard. Jim Pole-Langdon was formerly First Vice-President of the Federation, and is Immediate Past President of our Association.

Weston Library

Once again, we are able to present another chapter in the continuing saga of a new Weston Library! The need for improved library facilities seems to be agreed by all. As a result of public input last spring, the York Library Board has taken action toward placing an addition onto the present King Street Library. The aim is to provide a total of 12,000 square feet of library floor area, which will require the use of part of the playground of H.J. Alexander Public School.

The use of school land for the library requires approval by the Board of Education, and will probably involve a purchase. To determine how much school land is required, the Library Board was awaiting two decisions by the Board of Control, before any proposal goes to the Board of Education.

The first concerns the setback of the proposed building from King Street, as well as the proposed density. Due to the location and size of the site, exemptions to zoning regulations, in these regards, may have to be made.

Secondly, the Library Board does not have title to the present King Street site. When Weston amalgamated with the Borough of York in 1967, title to the library was passed onto the Borough, and not to the Library Board. Therefore, before doing any building, the Library Board is awaiting approval of the transfer of deeds, from the Borough to the Library Board.
