Programme

I. TANDEM.

Half mile with turn. Class IV. Open Canoes, single blades.

II. DOUBLE SCULLING.

Half mile with turn. Class IV. Sculling Canoes.

III. SINGLES.

Half mile with turn. Class IV. Open Canoes, single blades.

IV. FOUR.

Half mile with turn. Any Canoe 12 feet long or under, single blades.

V. HURRY SCURRY.

Req 100 yards, using 50 yards, and paddle to finish. Open canoes, any blade.

VI. HANDBAR TANDEM.

Half mile with turn. Class IV. Open Canoes, single blades.

VII. TANDEM UPSET.

Class IV Open Canoes, single blades.

VIII. SCULLING UPSET.

In Event VII, the canoes must be completely turned over and paddled across the finishing line.

In Event VIII, at a given pistol shot, the canoes must upset so as to make the top of the masthead touch the water and sail across the finishing line.

All canoes must start and finish bow first.

Competitors in Event II will not be eligible to enter Event III, and vice-versa.

All races will be started by a pistol shot.
